

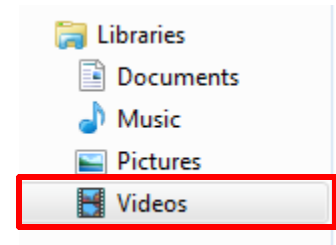
How to Import Clips into Windows Live Movie Maker 2012

Windows Movie Maker is a great tool for editing your video clips. However, before you can do that you must first import your video. This tutorial will teach you how to import your video into Windows Live Movie Maker 2012.

STEP 1


Know where the video you want to upload is saved on your computer

- Make sure you save it to somewhere that is appropriate so you can easily remember where to find it in the future. For example you could save it in your “videos” folder as picture to the right.



STEP 2

Open Windows Movie Maker

- If you don't already have Windows Movie Maker saved on your desktop you can find it on your PC by clicking the Windows start button (shown right) in the bottom left-hand corner of the screen and then searching for “Windows Movie Maker”. 

STEP 3

Click the “Add videos and photos” button.

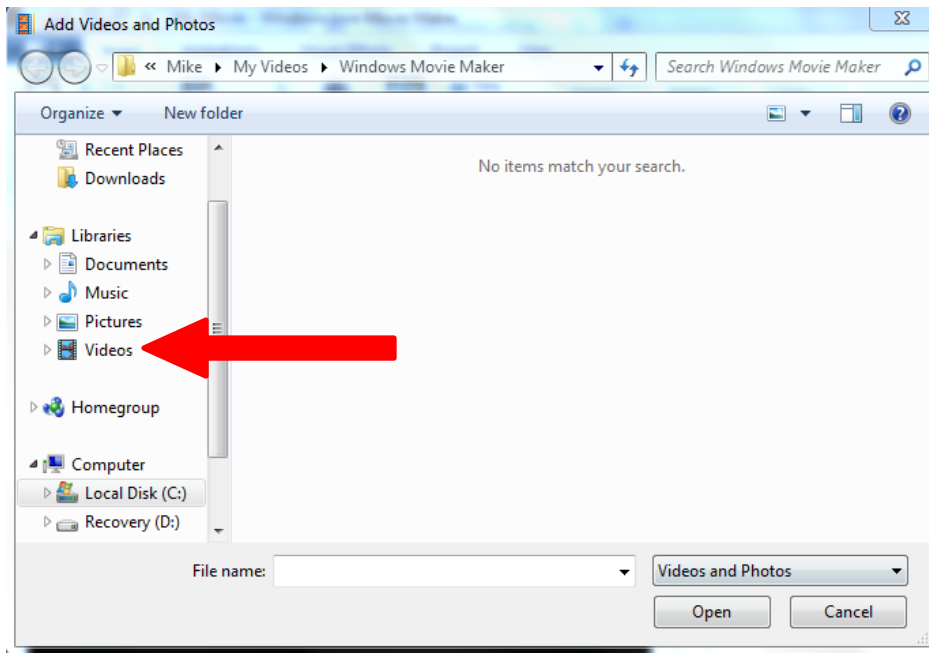
- This is located in the upper left-hand corner of Windows Movie Maker as shown in the picture below where it is circled in red.



STEP 4

Find the video file that you saved to your computer in step 1.

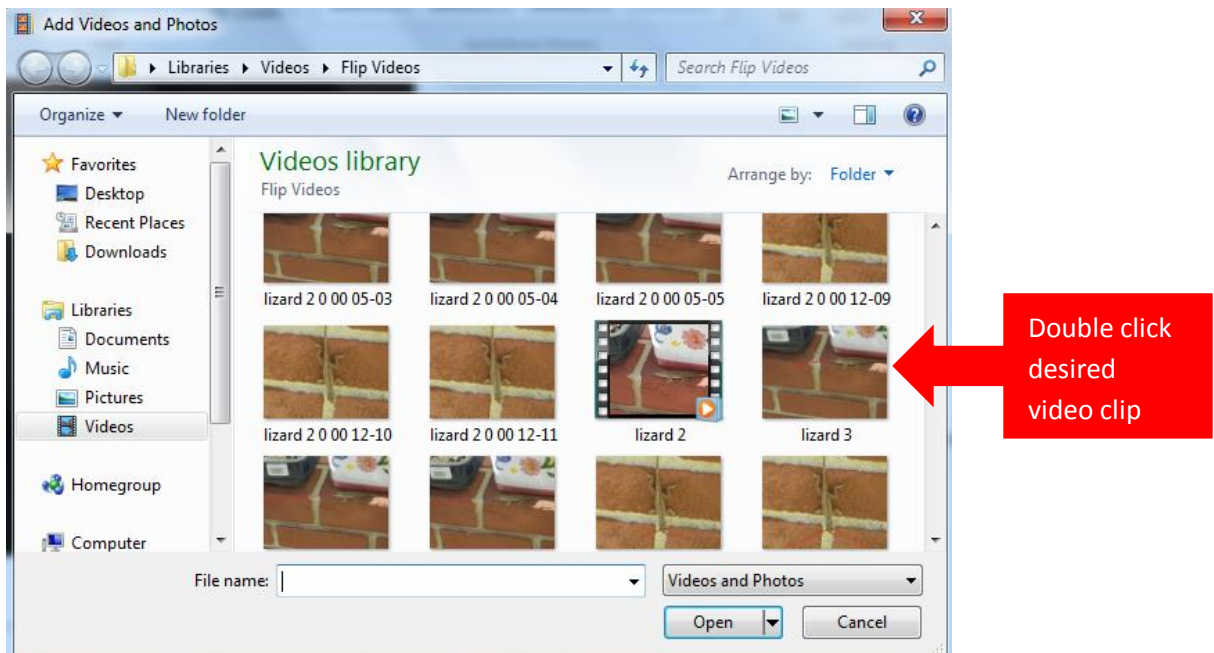
- Clicking the “Add videos and photos” will open the window shown below:



From here you can navigate to your saved video file by selecting from the folders on the left-hand side.

STEP 5

Double-click the clip that you want to import.

- Windows Movie Maker supports a variety of different file types:
 - .asf, .avi, dvr-ms, .m1v, .mp2, .mp2v, .mpe, .mpeg, .mpg, .mpv2, .wm, and .wmv

STEP 6

The clip should now be imported into Windows Movie Maker where you can edit it.

- It will now be in your video timeline as shown below. You can now edit it in Windows Movie Maker.
